## **National Business Group on Health Honors Fiserv as One of the Best Employers**

We also focused on information, because consistent, focused communications helps people make better choices related to their health and wellness."

One of the most popular Fiserv wellness campaigns, the Healthy You Fitness Challenge, began company-wide in 2006. It helped more than 8,000 employees accumulate nearly two million miles of walking, running and biking in the initial eight week event.

"We are very pleased to honor Fiserv for its support and dedication to providing a lifestyle improvement program, designed to reduce obesity and promote healthier lifestyles for employees," said Helen Darling, president of the Business Group. "They are true leaders who know the importance of supporting their employees' efforts to choose a healthier way of life."

Now in its third year, the Best Employers for Healthy Lifestyles awards acknowledge and reward those employers that recognize the urgent need to improve their workers' health, productivity and quality of life. The underlying goal of the program is to serve as a catalyst to encourage all employers to take action.

Winners of the Best Employers for Healthy Lifestyles awards were honored in one of three categories: Platinum, for established programs with measurable outcomes; Gold, for creating cultural and environmental changes that support employees who have made a commitment to long-term behavior changes; and Silver, for those employers who have launched significant programs or services to promote living a healthier lifestyle.
