Fiserv Gives Back: Volunteer Effort Exceeds Goal of 25,000 Hours, Supports Organizations in Atlanta and around the World

Brookfield, Wis., December 8, 2009 - Fiserv, Inc. Fiserv acquired CheckFree Corporation, which was headquartered in Norcross, Ga., in December 2007. Currently there are approximately 1,800 Fiserv associates in the Atlanta area.

The "Fiserv Gives Back: 25 for 25" community service program was launched in July to mark the 25th anniversary of the company and give its 20,000 employees an opportunity to volunteer together to multiply their positive impact in local communities. Fiserv used a database for employees to log hours supporting the organizations and efforts of their choice. Company associates have logged more than 27,000 hours since the summer and are continuing to donate every day.
